Mobile-first design.

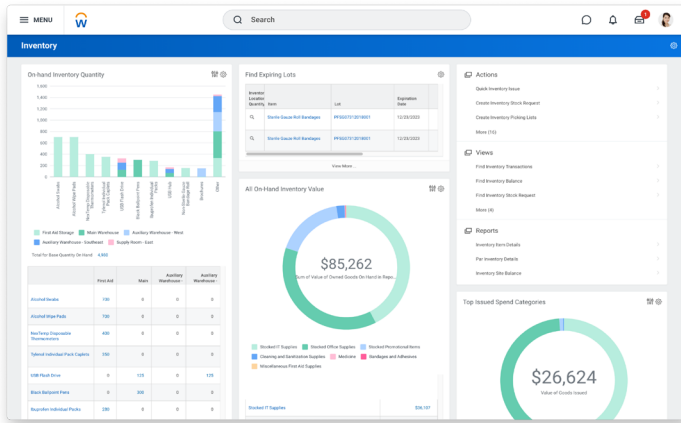

- Move and transfer inventory between sites and/or stocking locations
- Define and stock par locations
- Use bar-code scanning for quicker transaction entry
- Track lot numbers and lot expiration dates
- Follow chain of custody from dock to delivery
- Maintain nonconforming items with a clear recall audit trail

- Define basic attributes with an item master
- Value items using the perpetual average costing method
- Assign and manage different units of measure
- Set up inventory usage types and enable different attributes that can be used on multiple locations
- Manage consigned inventory
